- NFI kits were delivered to 5500 older vulnerable persons in the war affected area
- NFI and hot meals were distributed to 2160 older IDPs •
- Humanitarian aid was purchased and delivered to 21 nursing ٠ homes in the war affected area and nursing homes accommodated older IDPs
- TLU volunteers sewed 1800 bedding kits for nursing homes residents
- Information telephone lines for IDPs and war affected older
